

KDLA Players Code of Conduct

The Objective of the KDLA Players Code of Conduct is to make sure that every person, regardless of age, gender, level of skill, and position within the organization, has the opportunity to enjoy Minor Lacrosse without fear for physical abuse, hostility, discrimination or degradation of self.

ALL PLAYERS WILL ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. Work towards the goals and objectives of the Kemptville & District Lacrosse association, the Ontario Lacrosse Association and the Canadian Lacrosse Association.
2. Strive to achieve excellence in the sport, and heighten the image and dignity of the KDLA by refraining from any action or conduct which embarrasses or discredits the association.
3. Strive to achieve a safe and fair play environment free from any chemical or substance use or abuse.
4. Strive to show courtesy and respect for all players, coaches, referees, bench officials, and spectators.
5. Refrain from the use of obscene, profane, abusive or threatening language towards any other member of the KDLA, opposing team, spectators or officials.
6. Refrain from making any derogatory comment towards any person based upon race, ethnic origin, religious background, or gender.
7. Refrain from any attempt to purposely injure an opponent, player, coach, referee, bench official, or spectator, during practice or before, during or after a game.
8. Refrain from instigating a fight or becoming an aggressor to a fight whether on or off the playing floor.
9. Refrain from interfering with any member of the KDLA in the course of his or her official duties with respect to the safe and organized conduct of the game and the league.
10. Coaches may outline their own rules or processes that should be followed by their players, but can not be in contradiction to any of the above mentioned rules.

I have read and understand the above mentioned rules, and agree to follow the rules to the best of my abilities. I also understand that any infractions of these rules may be dealt with by the immediate discretion of my coach, an incident report may be completed, and a disciplinary committee may review the incident and may define any repercussions that will be required, that I am then obligated to follow.
